Course Overview:

This course is designed to address all areas of the IB Core: the extended essay (EE), CAS, and theory of knowledge (TOK). Within this course, students will have the opportunity to complete the TOK evaluation requirements, as well as receive structured support for the EE and CAS completion. While structured support for these areas is given, the responsibility for the completion of each area rests on the individual student.

Course Structure:

The course will be structured on a three-day cycle, so that each area of the core requirements is addressed. Students should access the course information page to ensure each is prepared with the needed materials for each class period.

Required Materials:

Grading:

Students will be assessed on each area of core and will include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Quality and volume of CAS reflections. These will be evaluated on a 0-3 scale for completion, detail, and appropriate inclusion of supporting materials (photos and so on)
